


The Humanitarian Data Exchange

Find, share and use humanitarian data all in one place


The Humanitarian Data Exchange (HDX) is an open platform for sharing data across platforms and organizations. The goal of HDX is to make humanitarian data easy to find and use for analysis. Launched in July 2014, HDX has been accessed by millions of users in over 250 countries and territories and brings together more than 20,500 datasets from over 290 partner organizations.

Share data publicly, privately with your colleagues or by requests.




The Humanitarian Exchange Language

A simple standard for messy data


The Humanitarian Exchange Language (HXL) is a data standard. It is based on spreadsheet formats such as CSV or Excel, but it adds hashtags with semantic information to allow software to validate, clean, merge and analyse data more easily.



Grab a spreadsheet of humanitarian data



Insert a new row between the headers and the data
