Methodology:

Accessed from "administraciuli erTeulebi", National Statistics Office of Georgia; modifications by OCHA.

The (transliterated) names in Georgian language was reviewed and corrected by the Ministry of Emergency Situations.

The administrative level 0-2 gazetteer was prepared by ITOS. An administrative level 3 supplementary gazetteer is also provided.

CAVEATS:

The gazetteer defines administrative level 3 features, but level 3 polygons are unavailable.

Administrative level 2 features are unavailable for Tbilisi, the Autonomous Republic of Abkhazia, and for the area known as the Provisional Administration.

The KMZ files were made at all levels from generalized (tolerance 0.001 degree) versions of the shapefiles due to the high number of vertices. The shapefiles provided are the originals.
