CAVEAT(S):

*Unusually, three administrative level 2 features: Las Golondrinas (EC9001); Manga del Cura (EC9003); and El Piedrero (EC9004), each containing only one administrative level 3 feature, do not belong to any province. Their administrative level 1 attribute is 'zona no delimitada'.

** Administrative level 3, with 1,025 features does not match the Ecuador COD Population Statistics (COD-PS) tables which have 1,040 features. For this reason no CSV file is provided for the administrative level 3.
