


YEMEN: Areas of control as at 31 July 2022



Summary:

The first week after Eid, violence across the country resulted in 58 civilian casualties, up 76% from the previous week. Explosive remnants of warfare, including landmines and UXO, were responsible for the highest number of civilian casualties, at 22, including 12 children, while cross border violence also resulted in 16 civilian casualties. Al Hodeidah, Ta'iz and Sa'dah were the most impacted governorates. The second week after Eid reported increased civilian casualties for a second consecutive week, up to 65, the highest weekly count reported since late May. Moreover, the number of child casualties more than tripled from the previous week, up to 38, the highest to be reported in one week since early 2020
