


YEMEN: Areas of control as at 27 August 2022



Summary:

During 11-17 August there were 18 reported civilian casualties marking a decrease for the third consecutive week, with most of the incidents reported in Al Hodeidah and Ta'iz. A single SAF incident in Sana'a resulted in four civilian casualties, however remnant explosive ordnance was responsible for the highest casualty number, with 4 casualties. During the week 18-24 August, civilian casualties increased by more than double, up to 39 people, mostly on account of landmines and UXO incidents across Al Hodeidah, Al Jawf, Ma'rib and Hajjah while the rest of casualties were reported in Sa'dah due to shellfire.
